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Subject: Annual (2021-2022) report of the Institution.

Strength:

The college has at present 414 students on its rolls with 17 full-fledged courses and 03 skill courses. Through consistent and continuous efforts we have applied for some new courses like BCA and Applied Mathematics. The staff of our college consist of 12 permanent teaching staff and 06 teachers as Academic Arrangement. At present, the college has 14 non-teaching staff. The faculty and students of the college continue their pursuit of quality in academic and research activities. Our results were well above the University average.

I take this occasion to congratulate the rank holders, and their respective class teachers and I wish the students all success in their future pursuits. Our students performed well to accomplish their goals. I would like to applaud the teamwork of the teaching and non-teaching staff community of the college and the committed and collaborative efforts of the students in the teaching-learning process. I am extremely thankful to the staff members for their profound support all the time. I am very happy to announce that we have signed an MoU with the Islamic University of Science and Technology (Awantipora) in Srinagar, Kashmir, to start a Skill course in our college.

Developmental works: The institutional strategic/perspective plan is effectively deployed. In the years 2021–2022, large-scale campus revamping was initiated while receiving funds for the development from the Higher Education Department of Jammu and Kashmir. The College has been sanctioned an amount of 3.29 crores during the year 2021-22 from Deptt. Of Higher education out of which 2.35 crores were utilised on different developmental works of the college. A project monitoring and development committee was constituted to monitor and implement the work successfully. The renovation work included revamping bathrooms, including plastering and plumbing, college canteen renovation and maintenance, and renovation of prefabricated Huts (used as classrooms). In sports sector Development of Cricket Play field, Kho-Kho court, Volley ball court and two Badminton courts are worth to mention against an amount of 3.96 Lakhs Sanctioned by District Administration under MGNREGA Scheme. In addition to this large amount, it was used for the purchases of microscopes, sports equipment, grass cutters, refrigerators, protocol items, Grass

cutters, lab chemicals, etc. The strategic plan of the college council of the large-scale renovation of the institution was thus effectively implemented during this period. An amount of 10 lakh was spent on the Automation of the Library during this year.

Faculity Development Programmes:

During this period, a good number of our teachers attended different workshops, FDPs and got their works published in various international and national journals. All the departments have subject associations which organize a number of activities for their members and motivate the students to participate in intercollegiate competitions. Most of the departments organized programmes, competitions and exhibitions and also participated in several intercollegiate competitions. Soft skill development programmes were also initiated by various subject associations; they also carry out extension activities in nearby institutions. IQAC of the College organized different Programme on E-Connect, E- Learning and E-Content tools for the teachers and students during the year. Following Teachers attended the programmes shown against each.




