### Editor' Note



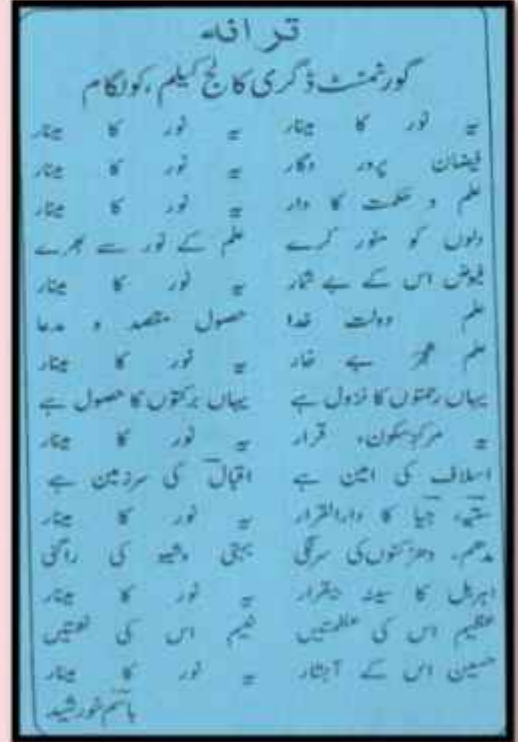

to summarize the achievements of our students, faculty and staff members.

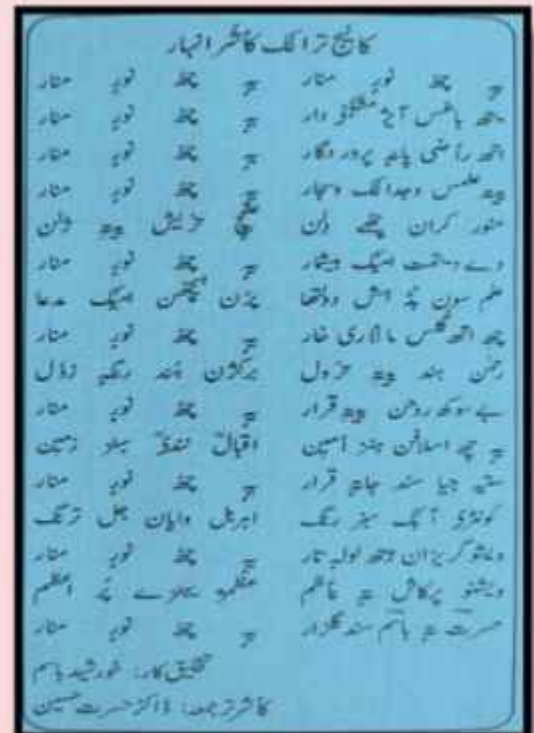

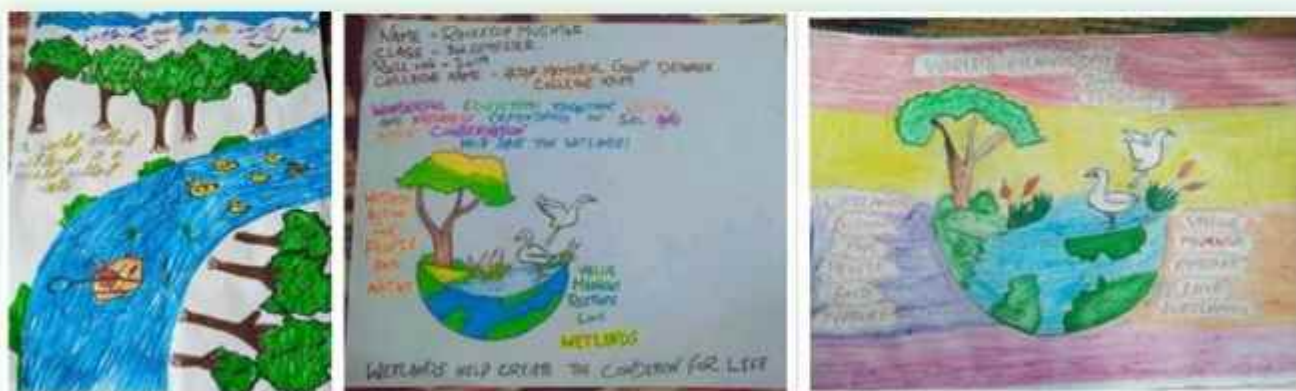

## Digital Week Celebrations, 2022 (25<sup>th</sup> July to 30<sup>th</sup> July)





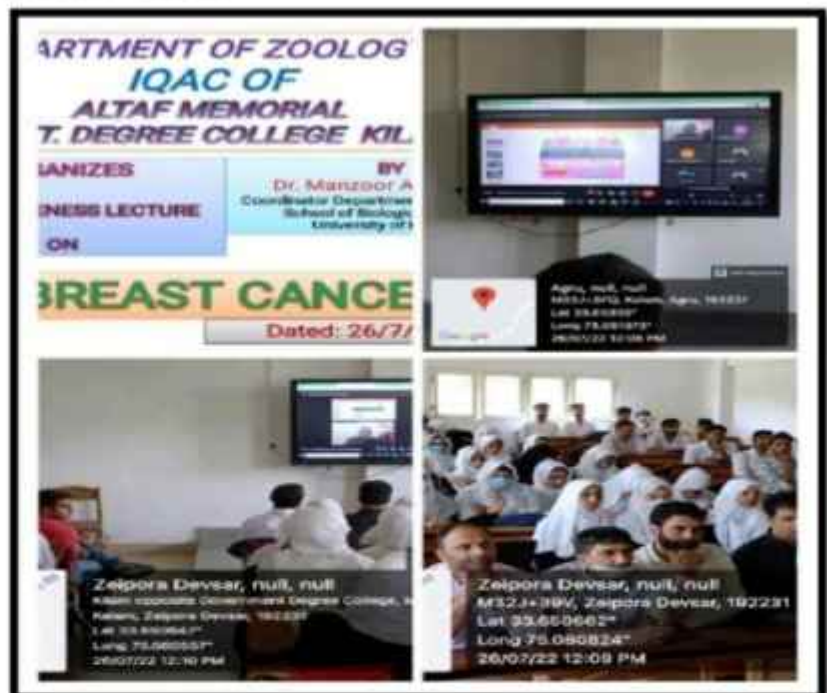
